General Notes

1. We would ask that your Son/Daughter travel to and from the Camp/Holiday **in uniform**.
2. **MOBILE PHONES are NOT permitted on camp.**
3. Black bin bags are not suitable for bedding rolls as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit. Day bag is for carrying small items on hikes, beach and day trips, packed lunches and drinks.
4. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name or initials.
5. Please label with either indelible ink and/or engraving as appropriate, with your Sons/Daughters Name. (The old favourites of paper labels held on with sticky tape, or nail varnish dots are not suitable. The paper labels wash off after the second or third meal, and it's amazing how many mums use the same shade of nail varnish).
6. Games or similar items (i.e. radios, walkman or cassette players) which require batteries to run are not allowed on camp.

Equipment Notes ~ Pocket Money ~ Jewellery

Here is some basic information regarding some of the items you may require / should be aware of.

Sleeping Bags	Synthetic filled bags are easier to clean than natural filling. Zips can be a source of cold if no baffle is fitted.
Footwear	Boots give a better ankle support and normally have better soles than shoes if you are hiking.
Warm Wear	A number of layers is warmer than one thick one and the warmth can be regulated more easily - do not forget your hands and head.
Torch	Do not pack your torch with batteries fitted (or at the bottom of your kit) as it could easily get accidentally turned on and you will arrive at the camp/holiday with flat batteries.
Camera	Do record you holiday if you have a camera. Expensive cameras are, however, not recommended.
Pocket Money	A certain amount of pocket money is recommended. Money may be handed to camp-leader for safety and will be given out as required. The Scout Group is otherwise not responsible for losses.
Jewellery	Earrings, nose rings, and other decorative jewellery are NOT recommended on camps and activities.
